The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of

sex.

Is guaranteed to all OITIZENS regardless of Gender

KEY ASPECTS OF THE AMENDMENT

THE RATIFICATION OF THE AMENDMENT WAS HASTENED BY WOMEN'S CONTRIBUTIONS AT HOME DURING WORLD WAR I IT DOUBLED THE VOTER BASE IN THE 1920 ELECTION IT INSTANTLY MADE WOMEN A POWERFUL POLITICAL FORCE IN AMERICAN POLITICS

THE TWENTIES AFTER GAINING SUFFRAGE, WOMEN IN THE 20s BEGAN TO ASSERT INDEPENDENCE, CHALLENGING TRADITIONAL VALUES, AND DEMANDING EQUAL RICHTS!

WOMEN WERE IDEAL FOR THESE JOBS B/C THERE WAS NO ROOM FOR PROMOTION, HIGHER PAY


2 million women workers clerical jobs, another 2 million on assembly lines


A woman's role in the family, marriage, society modernized

SHE THREW OFF THE STUFFY VICTORIAN RESTRICTIONS, EMBRACED URBAN STYLE & ATTITUDES


She was the symbol of Rebellious youth, sophisticated 20s women

SHE STAYED OUT ALL NIGHT W/ THE BOYS, SMOKED CIGARETTES, DRANK, PLAYED SPORTS


SHE WAS SASSY AND LIBERATED
