

They went to outdoor sporting events, athletes became heroes


BABE RUTH WAS THE ALGEST STAR OF ALL, JACK DEMPSEY WAS A CHAMPION BOXER


THESE HEROES SET NEW RECORDS, TESTED HUMAN LIMITS, PERSONIFIED AMERICAN SPIRIT

NON-STOP ALONE ACROSS THE ATLANTIC














"LUCKY LINDY" 1927

Americans were enchanted, and stars


LIKE CHARLIE CHAPIN, RUDOLPH VALENTINO

Composer George Gershwin became a Legendary Jazz artist


Painter Georgia O'Keefe and other artists embodied art-deco
