name **“OPERATION OVERLORD”**



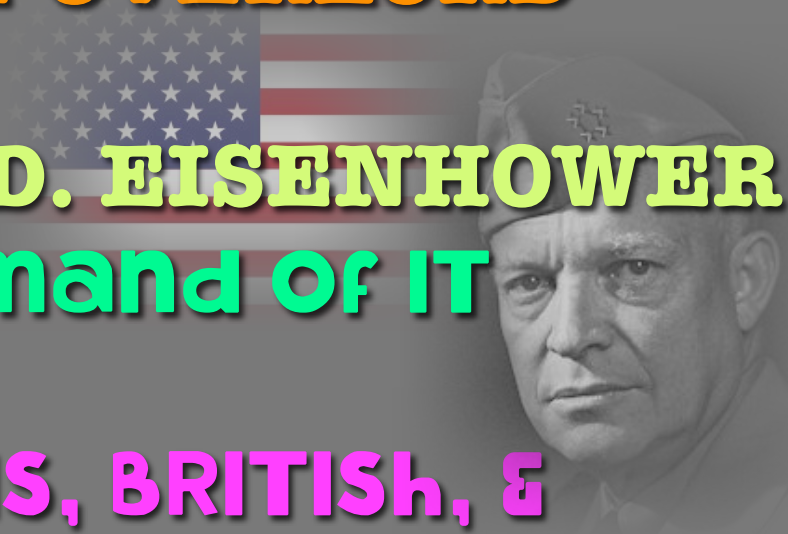
**US General DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER

“OPERATION OVERLORD”

June 6, 1944 - Allied forces attack the beaches of Normandy, France

Paratroopers dropped behind enemy lines to secure key sites

Pre-dawn naval bombardment of German defenses along the coast

3.5 million troops used amphibious crafts to land under heavy fire

Allies had built a phony army as a diversion for Germans at Calais

IT WORKED, AND HITLER REFUSED TO SEND REINFORCEMENTS TO NORMANDY

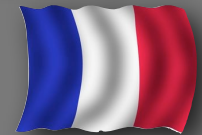
D-DAY

The Allies suffered an estimated **10,000 casualties** at **NORMANDY**

By early July, the Allies had landed nearly **1 MIL troops**, **180K vehicles** **TANKS, JEEPS, SUPPLIES, FORCES THAT WOULD PUSH INTO FRANCE & GERMANY**

By August, Gen. George S. Patton's **Third Army** rolled into France

LIBERATING FRANCE



8/25/44 - US AND FRENCH FORCES LIBERATE PARIS, DRIVE NAZIS INTO RETREAT

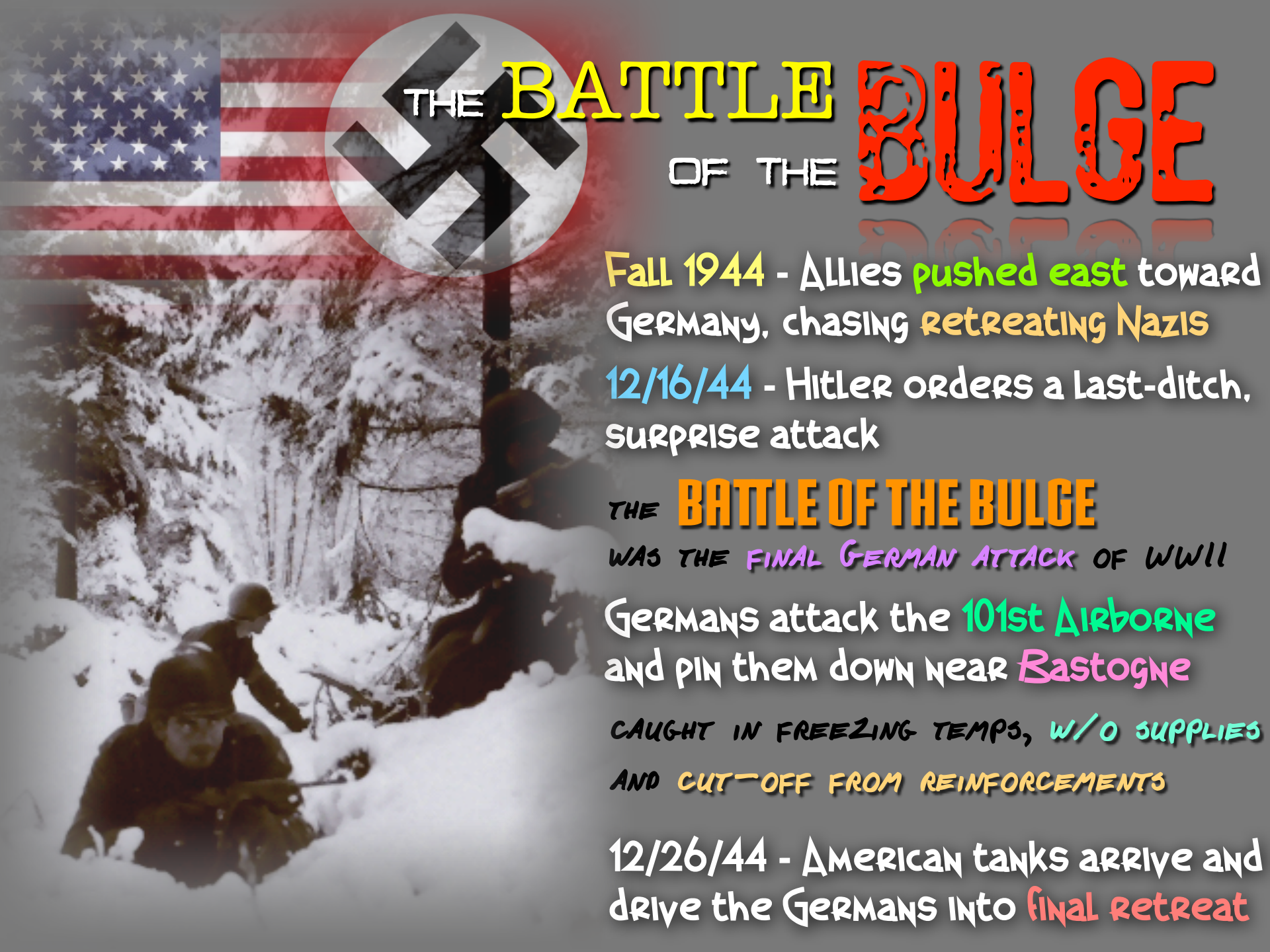
SEPT 1944 - WESTERN FRONT HAD BEEN RIPPED OPEN, GERMANY WAS IN RETREAT

THE BATTLE OF THE BULGE

Fall 1944 - Allies pushed east toward Germany, chasing retreating Nazis

12/16/44 - Hitler orders a last-ditch, surprise attack

THE BATTLE OF THE BULGE

WAS THE FINAL GERMAN ATTACK OF WWII

GERMANS attack the 101st Airborne and pin them down near Bastogne

CAUGHT IN FREEZING TEMPS, w/o supplies AND CUT-OFF FROM REINFORCEMENTS

12/26/44 - American tanks arrive and drive the Germans into final retreat

THE HORRORS OF THE HOLOCAUST



Allied troops **liberated** Nazi death camps in western & eastern fronts

SOVIETS WERE FIRST TO FIND **ATROCITIES**,
CONCENTRATION CAMPS IN POLAND

6 MILLION Jews were killed in **mass executions**, **concentration camps**
TO COVER UP THE EVIDENCE, **GERMANS**
CREMATED/BURIED MASS HEAPS OF BODIES

FDR had been **reluctant** to accept
Jewish refugees to America

ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE MEETING

After the war, Germany would be divided
into **4 military zones**, **occupied by Allies**

West Germany - **3 zones** (US, UK, France)

East Germany - **1 larger zone** (USSR)

City of **Berlin** - split into **4 military zones**

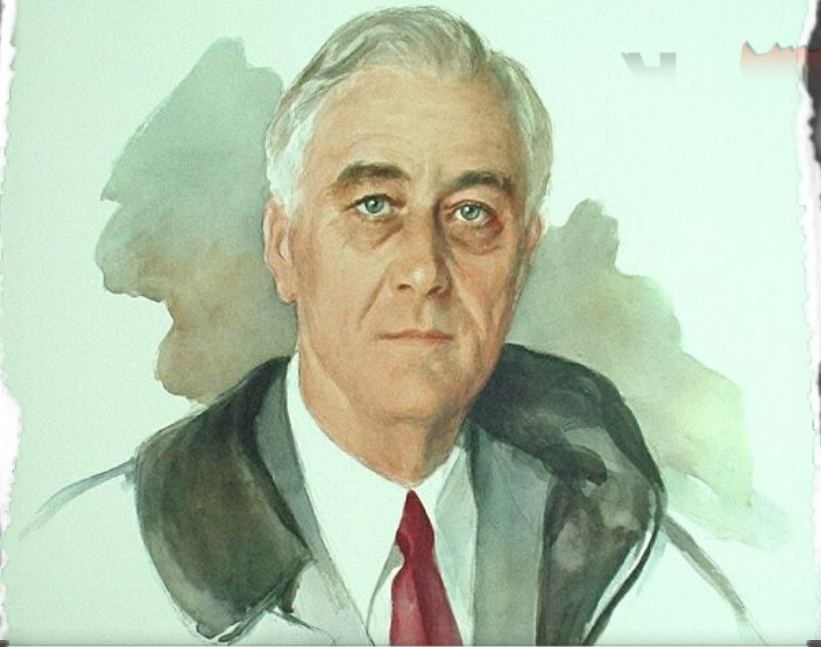

4/12/45 - FDR unexpectedly dies in Warm Springs, GA

FDR's sudden death was shocking, sank the nation into despair

Germany SURRENDERS

By APRIL 1945, German resistance was defeated & the Reich was done

4/20/45 - As the Soviets shelled Berlin, Hitler and his top officials committed suicide in his bunker

HITLER'S DEATH CAUSED DESERTIONS & SURRENDERS AMONG NAZI FORCES

5/7/1945 - Germany surrenders unconditionally to the Allies

5/8/45 - "V-E Day" (Victory in Europe) officially ends the war in Europe while the Pacific rages on
