

12/22/41 - FDR AND CHURCHILL MEET TO **DESIGN THE ALLIED PLAN FOR VICTORY**

THE FRIENDSHIP B/W THE TWO MEN IS LEGENDAR "IT IS FUN TO BE IN THE SAME DECADE AS YOU."

THE TWO, MEETING W/O STALIN, MAKE **TWO KEY DECISIONS:**



HITLER WAS THE BIGGER THREAT, SO THE DEFEAT OF GERMANY & ITALY WAS THE ALLIES PRIORITY



ONLY UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER OF THE AXIS POWERS WOULD BE ACCEPTED

DESPITE HIS DISTRUST OF THE WEST, STALIN AGREES TO ALLY WITH THE U.S & **ENGLAND TO FORM THE ALLIED POWERS**



BEFORE FIGHTING THE WAR IN EUROPE, THE U.S. HAD TO WIN THE BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC

HITLER ORDERED HIS WOLF PACK SUB FLEET TO SINK ALL ALLIED SHIPS

SPRING 1942 - AFTER A BITTER WINTER, THE NAZIS EASILY ROLLED THRU THE USSR

HITLER WANTED TO SEIZE SOVIET OIL FIELDS & CRUSH THE INDUSTRIAL CITY OF STALINGRAD


SOVIETS WERE ON THEIR HEELS, GERMANY SEEMED UNSTOPPABLE (SOVIETS: SURRENDER THE CITY?)

SEPT. 1942 - THE GERMANS HAD 90% OF THE CITY WHEN WINTER SET IN

W/ NAZIS STOPPED, THE SOVIET RED ARMY
RUSHED REINFORCEMENTS IN FOR COUNTERATTACK

SURROUNDED, FROZEN, STARVING,
GERMAN TROOPS END SIEGE & SURRENDER

A TURNING POINT ON THE EASTERN FRONT, THIS VICTORY ENDED HITLER'S HOPES FOR CONQUERING USER



WITH THE EASTERN FRONT IN TURMOIL, THE ALLIES MET TO DISCUSS THE INVASION OF EUROPE

STalin Pushed for the direct us/uk invasion of western europe




he hoped opening a western front would relieve his army in the east

MOSTLY TANK WARFARE, US TROOPS ARE LED BY


THE UNSTOPPABLE GENERAL GEORGE S. PATTON


PATTON'S 7TH ARMY PUSHED EAST AGAINST HITLER'S TOUGH AFRIKA KORPS.

DEFEATS WERE FOLLOWED BY MAGNIFICENT VICTORIES
AS US TROOPS GAINED VALUABLE EXPERIENCE

MAY 1943 - WITH THE BRITS PUSHING WEST OUT OF EGYPT, NAZI TROOPS RETREATED OUT OF TUNISIA TO ITALY

W/ VICTORY IN AFRICA, HITLER IS IN RETREAT ON TWO FRONTS AND THE ALLIES PLAN THEIR NEXT MOVE

JULY 1943 - ALLIES PURSUE RETREATI

GERMANS & INVADE SICILY

PATTON'S 7TH ARMY DOMINATED ITALIAN FORCES AND

CAPTURED THE ISLAND

FROM SICILY & TUNISIA, US TROOPS INVADED THE

ITALIAN PENINSULA

ITALIAN RESISTANCE COLLAPSES & THE ITALIAN PEOPLE DEPOSE MUSSOLINI

DETERMINED TO HOLD ITALY & KEEP ALLIES OUT OF GERMANY, HITLER SENDS MASSIVE REINFORCEMENTS

ALY WOULD BECOME A BLOODY & HARD **FOUGHT CAMPAIGN**
