



THE ALLIED WAR PLAN

THE DEFEAT AT PEARL HARBOR HAD MISSED THE US CARRIERS AND SUB FLEET

THE US WOULD HAVE TO DEFEND THE PACIFIC WITH AIRCRAFT & SUBS UNTIL THE PACIFIC BATTLESHIP FLEET COULD BE REPAIRED

IN ADDITION, THE TYPE OF WARFARE WOULD BE VERY DIFFERENT FROM EUROPE

JAPAN'S EMPIRE STRETCHED OVER THE WATER & ISLANDS, SO IT WOULD REQUIRE ISLAND HOPPING

A STRATEGY OF NAVAL BOMBARDMENTS FOLLOWED BY MARINE LANDINGS FROM ISLAND TO ISLAND

THE US WOULD NEED THE HELP OF THEIR AUSTRALIAN ALLIES IN THE SOUTH PACIFIC TO PULL OFF VICTORY!

AMERICA FIGHTS BACK


THE DOOLITLE RAID 4 MONTHS AFTER PEARL, 16 US PLANES PULL OFF DARING BOMBING RAID ON TOKYO

IT LIFTED US SPIRITS, SHOCKED JAPAN INTO REALIZATION US COULD FIGHT BACK HARD!

BATTLE OF THE CORAL SEA US & AUSTRALIAN FORCES DEFEAT JAPANESE INVASION FORCE IN ALL-AIR BATTLE

ALLIED VICTORY TURNED BACK JAPANESE INVASION OF AUSTRALIA, KEPT IMPORTANT ALLY SAFE

BATTLE OF GUADALCANAL 1ST ACTION SEEN BY MARINES IN WWII, JAPAN FAILED TO HOLD A VITAL AIR FIELD (BOMB AUS)



"AVENGED PEARL HARBOR"

JUNE 1942 - US LAUNCH A CARRIER ATTACK ON THE JAPAN. CARRIER FLEET

CAUGHT OFF-GUARD, THE JAPANESE ARE EASY TARGETS FOR US TORPEDO PLANES & BOMBERS BY BATTLE'S END, THE JAPANESE HAD LOST 4 CARRIERS, I DESTROYER, AND 250 PLANES

THE ALLIED VICTORY AT MIDWAY IS A TURNING POINT IN THE PACIFIC WAR

W/ THE JAPANESE CARRIER FLEET CRIPPLED, THE US HAD AIR DOMINANCE & STARTED ISLAND HOPPING

THE <u>NAVAJO CODE TALKERS</u> PLAYED A MAJOR ROLE IN THE VICTORY


NAVAJO MARINES USED THE ANCIENT NAVAJO LANGUAGE AS CODE TO CONFUSE THE JAPANESE THROUGHOUT WWIL

WITH A SIGNIFICANT NAVAL VICTORY AT MIDWAY, THE US BEGAN A MAJOR OFFENSIVE The PUSh INVOLVed neutralizing The Rest of the Japanese navy

IN desperation, Japan Implemented kamikaze attacks

BUT THE KAMIKAZES COULDN'T STOP THE US Advance Toward Japan

"SULFUR ISLAND"

FEB. 1945 - MARINES LAND ON THE MOST Fortified Island on Earth - Iwo Jima

OVER ZOK JAPANESE WERE ENTRENCHED IN DEFENSE

HEAVY NAVAL BOMBARDMENT DID LITTLE TO SOFTEN DEFENSES & LANDING WAVES TOOK HEAVY LOSSES


6000 MARINES DIED TAKING THE ISLAND, ONLY 200 JAPANESE SURVIVED

THE VICTORY WAS IMMORTALIZED BY THE IMAGE OF MARINES RAISING THE FLAG ON MOUNT SURIBACHI

GENERAL DOUGLAS MACARTHUR RETOOK THE PHILIPPINES IN 1944

COMBINED WITH THE VICTORY AT INO JIMA, THE US COULD NOW PLAN AN INVASION OF THE LAST ISLAND STRONGHOLD OUTSIDE JAPAN: OKINAWA





THE BATTLE OF OKINAWA (1945)



THE BLOODIEST BATTLE

APRIL 1945 - US ASSUALTS THE ISLAND OF OKINAWA, ONLY 350 MILES OFF JAPAN

ABOUT 2000 KAMIKAZES KILLED 5K SAILORS, SUNK 30 AMERICAN SHIPS MARINES FACED TOUGHER RESISTANCE THAN INO JIMA B/C OF TUNNELS AND CAVES FILLED W/ 100KS


JUNE 1945 - THE US CONTROLLED THE Island, but at an enormous cost

THE US LOST OVER 7000 MEN, MORE THAN INO JIMA

JAPAN LOST 110,000, INCLUDING RITUAL SUICIDES

W/ OKINAWA AND IWO JIMA TAKEN, THE Stage was set for the invasion of Japan
